# REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31<sup>st</sup> MARCH 2006

Dear Members,

It gives your managing committee and me pleasure in presenting its 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Report for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2006. Your committee has tried to curtail losses and has managed to reduce them despite adverse circumstances and low interest rates.

**ACCOUNTS:** The Audited accounts of the association for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2006 are hereby presented. Your committee has managed to retain a satisfactory financial state of the association with judicious control and monitoring. We hope that this endeavor will continue and better results are expected in the current year.

**INVESTMENTS:** Our investments stand at Rs 6, 49, 273/- The investments are earning us an average return of 6.08 %, this not considering the services charges received. We are still attempting to improve our performance by increasing our membership procuring sponsorships and cutting down expenditure.

**MEMBERSHIP:** The total membership as at the date of printing the balance sheet stood at 1245 as compared to the previous year's figures of about 1048. During the year under review 52 new members were admitted. Details of membership during the year are presented in the following pages.

## REVIEW OF ASSOCIATION'S ACTIVITIES:

1. CAREER GUIDANCE LECTURES: Your committee conducted two career guidance lectures for the students of class 10 of the batch of 2006. They were as follows

- Keki is an ex-student of Champion School class of 1970. Born on 7/11/1954 he belonged to the Xavier house having been registered as No. 1772. He obtained a Bachelors Degree in Commerce from Bombay University and is a qualified Chartered Accountant. He is a Fellow Member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and also a member of the Michigan Association of Certified Public Accountants

USA. Keki started his career with The India Hotels Company Limited – one of the largest chain of hotels in India. In 1981 he joined Housing Development Finance Corporation - HDFC and was inducted in the Board of Directors as an Executive Director in the year 1993. He was made Managing Director in November 2000 and is also director on the Board of several Indian Companies such as HDFC Bank and Standard Life Insurance. He is presently playing a very important role in maintaining the interest rates in the field of housing finance.

He was the Deputy Managing Director of HDFC from 1999 and was later appointed as the Managing Director of HDFC Ltd in 2000. Mr. Mistry is a Member of the Managing Committee of the Bombay Chamber of Commerce and Industry; a Director of the Association or Leasing & Financial Services Companies.
